As you are aware the state budget continues to dive deeper into horrific shortfalls, especially for education.

This bond issue was a proactive attempt by your school district to offer superior educational opportunities in the midst of school funds continuing to decline. Plans are being made to update teacher technology tools that have reached their end. Additionally, we look forward to the opportunities we will have for new curriculum tools that align with new state standards. Keep in mind that the State Department of Education changed standards and withdrew state funding for curriculum at the same time. The remainder of the funds you approved will be used to maintain our school district. We recognize that over the next three years there will be significant maintenance costs to HVAC, roof projects, etc. We also know that our existing building funds will be declining as gross production has continued to decrease.
